



GREEK TRANSLATOR/LOGISTICS OFFICER – Volunteer position

Our team of lawyers, protection officers, legal assistants, translators, psychologist and experts from different academic backgrounds, provides legal aid, protection and psychosocial services to refugees and asylum seekers on Lesbos, with the support of over 20 volunteers working remotely on translation, research, communication and fundraising.

We are looking for an independent, adaptable and responsible individual who is willing to work in an emergency setting. Our clients need great advocates who demonstrate compassion, patience, hard work and empathy in extremely trying circumstances. The successful candidate must be an excellent communicator, a cooperative, respectful team player, and have the ability to multitask and prioritize in a constantly shifting context.

Job Description

Under the supervision of the Operations Coordinator, the Logistics Officer will undertake and monitor the logistic work associated with Fenix's operations, ensuring that all logistic matters are dealt with in accordance with the organizational standards and policies. Besides, the translator will be responsible to provide written translation and oral interpretation, working in close collaboration with the legal, protection, mental health team, development and administrative team. The translator is also required to accompany Fenix member and clients to public and private offices when necessary.

Job requirements

- Office management and maintenance, including organization's resources (cars, volunteer houses, etc.)
- Ensure positive supplier and vendor relationships
- Identify and assist with administrative, logistic, and material needs
- Written translation and in person interpretation from Greek to English and vice versa.
- All Fenix team members must comply with the values and principles outlined in the Fenix code of conduct and Policies

- Greek (C1/C2)
- Excellent organizational skills
- Passion for human rights
- Ability to work within a team
